Tour Highlights

Thursday Evening (6:30 pm) Pre Tour Presentations:

- The ranch, what it is and what's happening—it's a busy place.
- Local land-use history—from those who know.
- Geologic and geomorphic setting—large diversity in a small area.
- Soils and tour overview—including LIDAR images.

Friday Field Tour and Activities:

- Soils and land-use on marine terraces.
- Soils and organic culinary herb farming on the Scotts Creek floodplain.
- Watercourse realignment and rehabilitation.
- Steelhead and salmon monitoring.
- Educational program in natural resources, earth sciences, and agriculture.
- PSSAC business discussions.
- BBQ among the redwoods with uplifting ocean view and great company.

Saturday Field Tour and Activities:

- Geology-soils-hydrology-forestry-fire in redwood and Douglas-fir forests.
- Some soils are stable, others are not.
- Soil conditions, hillslope erosion, and salvage logging after the 2009 Lockheed fire.
- Stream channel responses and water quality monitoring.
- Lunch-time train ride.

Where is it again?

Cal Poly's Swanton-Pacific Ranch, on Swanton Rd., about 2 miles north of Davenport. Where's Davenport? On Hwy 1 about 10 miles north of Santa Cruz. (Note: Swanton Rd. connects with Hwy 1 in two places: from the south, it's about 1 mi north of Davenport (turn right); and from the north it's immediately south of Big Creek Lumber mill (turn left). Park at the "Red House" on Swanton Road immediately south of the Little Creek bridge.

LOGISTICS

Lodging

Participants must make their own lodging reservations. A partial list of near-by accommodations is given below. No lodging is available at Swanton-Pacific Ranch, except that students are welcome to camp-out in open dormitory style in canvas-covered yurts on the Ranch (reservation required).

The driving distance from the northern end of Santa Cruz to Swanton-Pacific Ranch is about 13 miles.
